



Rename Yourself



On the computer, hover over your video and click the 3 dots for the “rename” option to appear; this can also be done in the participants panel

In mobile, use the “participants” panel, click on your name, and then the option to rename yourself will come up at the bottom



If you are having difficulties, select the audio options next to the microphone to adjust, and “switch to phone audio” if you need to use your phone as a mic.




Video

Start and stop your video by clicking on the video camera icon




